

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Franzoy & Corey make a full disclosure of its ownership and interest
and existing contracts with the Papago Tribe)

RES. NO. 184-86

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has heard that certain members of the Council are
2 concerned about the possibilites of conflicts of interest involving
3 the engineering firm of Franzoy & Corey and its work for the Papago
4 Tribe; and

5 WHEREAS, The Papago Council wishes to avoid even an appearance of impropriety
6 in its relationship with its engineering consultant.


7 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby request
8 the firm of Franzoy & Corey to submit, (1) a list of all persons or
9 entities having an ownership interest in the firm, (2) a list of all
10 clients with whom the firm presently has professional contracts, and
11 (3) a list of all contracts which the firm presently has with the
12 Papago Tribe.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 28th
15 day of February, 1986 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
16 1,587.5 for; -0- against; 52.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
17 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (f) of Article
18 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
19 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
20 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
21 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
22 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
23 enactment by the Papago Council.
