

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Papago Education Department & Early Childhood Headstart Program to develop
Guidelines, Policies & Procedures for Background check & screening)

RES. NO. 18-86

1 WHEREAS, The staff and employees of the Papago Education Department and the
2 Papago Early Childhood Headstart program work with and are in constant
3 contact with the Papago Children; and

4 WHEREAS, The Papago Education Department and the Papago Early Childhood
5 Headstart program do not have a set of guidelines, policies and
6 procedures that will protect Papago Children from the possibility of
7 abuse, neglect, cruelty or depravity; and

9 WHEREAS, It will be in the best interest of the Papago Tribe that the
10 necessary guidelines, policies and procedures be developed that would
11 require the proper background checks and the continuing screening and
12 monitoring of all existing and future staff and employees of the
13 Papago Education Department and the Early Childhood Headstart program
14 for the purpose of protecting Papago Children from child abuse,
15 neglect, cruelty or depravity.

16 WHEREAS, these guidelines, policies and procedures should include safe guards
17 that would prevent child abuse, neglect, cruelty or depravity to
18 occur to any children while in the custody or care of the Education
19 Department and the Early Childhood Headstart program.

21 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Education department and the
22 Papago Early Childhood Headstart program develop a set of guidelines,
23 policies and procedures that will require the proper background checks
24 and the continuing screening and monitoring of all existing and future
25 staff and employees of the Papago Education Department and the Early
26 Childhood Headstart program for the purposes of protecting Papago
27 Children from child abuse, neglect, cruelty or depravity.


29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these guidelines, policies and procedures shall

31 neglect, cruelty or depravity of any child while in the custody or
32 care of the Education Department and the Early Childhood Headstart

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this set of guidelines, policies, and procedures be completed and delivered to this Council for review and approval by July 15, 1986.



Said Resolution is effective on the day of enactment of the Papago Council
