RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL (Disapproving Sells District Res. 0286 contract between O'Odham Construction)

RES. NO. <u>191-86</u> WHEREAS, The Sells District Council did by Resolution No. 0286 approve an agreement which would permit O'Odham Construction Materials and Company ("Company") to mine, sand, gravel and rock within the Sells District upon condition that members of the District be given certain employment preferences by the Company; and WHEREAS, the agreement was brought to this Council; and WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council believes that the employment preference for members of the Sells District contained in the agreement is pre-empted

by the Tribe's Employment Rights Ordinance and may violate Section 2 of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation which guarantees to all members of the Tribe an equal opportunity to participate in the economic activities and resources of the Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it does hereby disapprove the agreement referred in Resolution No. 0286 of the Sells District Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the $\underline{12th}$ day of March, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1139.0 for; 374.0 against; 127.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution was presented for approval to the Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham Nation on the $\frac{\sqrt{4^{\circ}}}{2^{\circ}}$ day of $\frac{\sqrt{4^{\circ}}}{2^{\circ}}$ 1986, at $\frac{4!/6}{2^{\circ}}$ o'clock, $\frac{1}{2^{\circ}}$.M., pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of Article VII of the Constitution and will become effective upon his approval; provided, however, that if it was passed by the Council pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 of Article VI of the Constitution it shall become effective only upon the further approval of the Secretary of the Interior.
