

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
Approving funding for Solid Waste Program for Sells Community

RES. NO. 197-86

1 WHEREAS, Sells District Council did by Resolution No. 0586 request the Tohono
2 O'Odham Council to provide additional financial support to the Solid
3 Waste Program serving the Sells Community because the program is run-
4 ning out of funds; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed the financial status of the
6 program; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council is desious that the Tribe continue oper-
8 ation of the program in order to protect the health and welfare of the
9 residents of the community.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it does
12 hereby approve increased funding, as necessary, for the Solid Waste
13 Program for the next six months; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer work with the Well Maintenance Dir-
15 irector to develop alternative revenue sources for the program for
16 review by the Council in cooperation with the Health Director and
17 other interested persons.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 13th
20 day of March, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1454.0 for; 69.0 against; 117.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
22 powers vested in the Council by Section 2 (d) (2) and (3) of Article VI of the
23 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation
24 on January 18, 1986, and approved by Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
25 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
26 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution was presented for approval to
the Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham Nation on the 4th day of December, 1986, at
4:15 o'clock, P.M., pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of Article VII
of the Constitution and will become effective upon his approval; provided, how-
ever, that if it was passed by the Council pursuant to the powers vested in the
Council by 2 of Article VI of the Constitution it shall become effective only
upon the further approval of the Secretary of the Interior.
