

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Personnel Department & Education Department take immediate steps to check the backgrounds of the Tribes' Early Childhood Headstart Program)

RES. NO. 19-86

1 WHEREAS, The State of Arizona through the Arizona Department of Education has
2 demanded, that as a requirement to the releasing funds to the Tribe
3 under the Child Care Food Program, that all Tribal Day Care Center
4 employees and Tribal Day Care Home providers sign affidavits, a copy
5 of which is attached hereto, and made a part hereof; and

7 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has the ability and the personnel necessary to do
8 the necessary background checking and screening of the staff and
9 employees of its Day Care Centers and its Day Care Home providers
10 under the Papago Personnel Policies without turning this matter over
11 to the State of Arizona which would be an infringement upon the tribal
12 sovereign jurisdiction.

14 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Personnel Department and the Education
15 Department take the necessary steps immediately to check the back-
16 grounds of the existing staff and employees of the Tribes' Child Care
17 Centers and the Tribes' Day Care Home providers for the purpose of
18 protecting Papago Children from the possibility of child abuse,
19 neglect, cruelty or depravity and report the results thereof to this
20 Council as soon as possible.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th
23 day of January, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
24 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
25 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(e), (f) and (h) of Article
26 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
27 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secre-
28 tary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
29 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
30 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
31 the Papago Council.
