

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Approving Gu Vo District Budget Amendment FY 86)

RES. NO. 198-86

1 WHEREAS, The Gu Vo District did submit the Gu Vo District Community budgets  
2 and the budget of the Redirections Program; and

3  
4 WHEREAS, The Gu Vo District did on January 20, 1986 approve and adopt the  
5 Community budgets and the budget of the Redirections Program and by  
6 resolution approved an amendment to the FY 86 District Budget in-  
7 creasing the budget by \$40,900.00;

8 WHEREAS, The Gu Vo District has sufficient funds in its IIM Account to cover  
9 the increase in the budget; and

10 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the proposed budget amendment and  
11 approves of the same;

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
14 approve the attached budget amendment in the amount of \$40,900.00  
15 increasing the Gu Vo District FY 86 Budget to \$93,884.00 and  
16 authorizes expenditures in accordance with the budgets attached.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 13th  
18 day of March, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
19 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers  
20 vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the  
21 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,  
22 1986, and approved by Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)  
23 on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
24 984). Said Resolution was presented for approval to the Chairman of the  
25 Tohono Odham Nation on the 31st day of March, 1986, at      o'clock,  
26     .M., pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of Article VII of the Consti-  
27 tution and will become effective upon his approval; provided, however, that if  
28 it was passed by the Council pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
29 Section 2 of Article VI of the Constitution it shall become effective only  
30 upon the further approval of the Secretary of the Interior.
