

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Adoption into Tribal Membership)

RES. NO. 200-86

1 WHEREAS, FLORES, Damian M.; VELASCO, Elisa; have made applications for adoption  
2 into Tribal membership pursuant to Section 2 of Article II of the  
3 Constitution of the Papago Tribe; and

4 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has reviewed their respective applications,  
5 had made a final determination that they are 1-1/2 degree or more of  
6 Papago Indian blood, and have made a recommendation to the Papago  
7 Council that their applications be approved, all in accordance with  
8 the provisions with the Papago Enrollment Ordinance; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the recommendation of the Enrollment  
10 Committee and the evidence submitted in support of the individual  
11 applications.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the applications for

15 2821-S-76 FLORES, Damian M. 92-ND-84 VELASCO, Elisa


16 are hereby approved and they are hereby adopted into membership of the  
17 Papago Tribe.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th day  
20 of March 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1449.5  
21 for; -0- against; 190.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the authority  
22 vested in the Papago Council by Article II and Article V, Section 2 (f) of the  
23 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by  
24 the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the  
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of  
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago  
Council.
