

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Approving lease and sublease for Sells Aquatic
and Recreation Center)

RES. NO. 209-86

- 1 WHEREAS, Save the Children and the Sells District Council have
2 proposed the construction of a semi-public swimming pool
3 to be located in Sells for the joint use by the children
4 attending Indian Oasis School District No. 40 ("School
5 District") and by members of the Tohono O'odham Nation
6 ("Nation"), and to be known as the Sells Aquatic and
7 Recreation Center ("Center"); and
- 8 WHEREAS, the School District has proposed to lease the land and
9 construct the swimming pool and associated and appurten-
10 ant facilities which will constitute the Center at a cost
11 not to exceed \$225,000 and, upon substantial completion
12 of the construction, to sublet the completed Center to
13 the Nation pursuant to a sublease which will permit the
14 School District to use it for swimming classes and ath-
15 letic events during the school year, and will permit the
16 Nation to maintain and operate it for members of the
17 Nation at other times; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Save the Children and the Sells Community have made cer-
19 tain commitments to the Nation to cover some of the main-
20 tenance and operation costs to be undertaken by the Na-
21 tion pursuant to the terms and conditions of the proposed
22 sublease; and
- 23 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Council believes that it will be to
24 the benefit of the school children and members of the
25 Nation that the Center be constructed, operated and main-
26 tained as envisioned in the proposed lease and sublease
27 between the Nation and the School District; and
- 28 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Council has discussed and reviewed the
29 form of the proposed Lease from the Tohono O'odham Nation
30 to the Indian Oasis School District No. 40, and of the
31 proposed Sublease from the School District back to the
32 Nation, both of which were submitted to this meeting, as

1 well as the proposition for the construction, operation
2 and maintenance of the Sells Aquatic and Recreation
3 Center.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Council
5 does hereby approve, and that the Chairman of the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation is hereby authorized on behalf of the
7 Nation to execute and deliver as many counterparts as
8 shall be deemed advisable of a Lease to the Indian Oasis
9 School District No. 40, substantially in the form of the
10 Lease submitted to this meeting, with such changes in the
11 form of the Lease as the Chairman shall deem advisable.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Council does hereby
13 approve, and the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation is
14 hereby authorized on behalf of the Nation to execute and
15 deliver as many counterparts as shall be deemed advisable
16 of a Sublease from the Indian Oasis School District No. 40
17 substantially in the form of the Sublease submitted to
18 this meeting, with such changes in the form of the Sub-
19 lease as the Chairman shall deem advisable.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Council does hereby
21 approve and adopt the attached budget for the operation
22 and maintenance of the Sells Aquatic and Recreation
23 Center, and does hereby amend the FY 1986 budget of the
24 Tohono O'odham Nation accordingly.

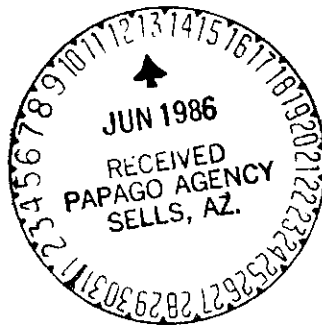
25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
26 on the 21st. day of March, 1986, at a meeting at which
27 a quorum was present with a vote of 1502.0 for; -0- against;
28 -0- not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the powers
29 vested in the Council by Section 2(d) of Article VI of the Consti-
30 tution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
31 Nation on January 13, 1986, and approved by Deputy Assistant Sec-
32 retary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Res-
olution was presented for approval to the Chairman of the Tohono
O'odham Nation on the 26th day of March, 1986, at 2:40
o'clock, P.M., pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of
Article VII of the Constitution and will become effective upon his
approval; provided, however, that if it was passed by the Council
pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 of Arti-

1 cle VI of the Constitution it shall become effective only upon the
2 further approval of the Secretary of the Interior.
