

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Congressional funding for in-situ leaching)

RES. NO. 21-86

1 WHEREAS, Congress has appropriated funds in the fiscal year 1986 budget to
2 finance an in-situ leaching pilot project in the Casa Grande, Arizona,
3 area for the purpose of testing the feasibility of leaching, through
4 the use of chemicals, copper from underground solid rock; and

5
6 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Mines has been authorized to select a site in the Casa
7 Grande area for this experimental project; and

8 WHEREAS, The Operator (Noranda Mining Co.) of the Papago Tribe's Lakeshore
9 mining properties, working with the U. S. Bureau of Mines, has, since
10 1983, been conducting a research and development program on the
11 feasibility of leaching, through the use of chemicals, copper from
12 underground solid rock; and

14 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe, through the reduction of its rights to advance
15 royalties, has contributed, since 1983, over two million dollars and
16 is now contributing seventy-five thousand dollars per month to enable
17 Noranda to conduct its research and development program of in-situ
18 leaching of copper from solid rock at the Tribe's Lakeshore Mine; and

19 WHEREAS, The income from the Lakeshore Mine is critical to the continued sta-
20 bility of the Papago Tribal Government; the District governments and
21 the Papago people; and

23 WHEREAS, It would save the Federal Government money and time if the funds
24 appropriated for this project are utilized to continue the existing
25 research and development project of in-situ leaching of copper from
26 solid rock at the Lakeshore Mine; and

27 WHEREAS, It would be in the best interest of the Papago Tribe if the funds
28 appropriated for this project are utilized for the continuance of
29 research and development project at its Lakeshore Mine.


30 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman, the Mining Committee, the
31 mining advisor, the Attorney and Lobbyist do all things necessary,
32 including, but not limited to, contacting our Congressional


delegation, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the Department of the Interior and the Bureau of Mines to require that the allocation of those funds appropriated by Congress, in the fiscal year 1986 budget, to finance an in-situ leaching pilot project, be utilized for the continued research and development of leaching copper from underground solid rock at the Papago Tribe's Lakeshore Mine.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 27th day of January, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1577.0 for; -0- against; 63.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(a) and (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
