Said Resolution was presented for approval to the Chair-Tohono O'Odham Nation on the ____ day of ____, 1986, at ____.M. pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of Article VII of the man of the Tohono O'Odham Nation on the _____ Constitution and will become effective upon his approval; provided, however, that if it was passed by the Council pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 of Article VI of the Constitution it shall become effective only upon the further approval of the Secretary of the Interior.
