

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Confirming selection of Secretary of the Council)

RES. NO. 222-86

1 WHEREAS, Section 5 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham  
2 Nation requires the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council to select a  
3 Secretary from without its membership.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council does hereby confirm its  
5 selection of Ophelia Campillo to continue as Secretary of the Council  
6 to serve until replaced by the Council.

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8 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th  
9 day of April, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
10 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers  
11 vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the  
12 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,  
13 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
14 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
15 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
