8	1. Seal: Change the words "GREAT SEAL OF THE PAPAGO TRIBE" to GREAT
9 10	SEAL OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION;" and the date "1937" to "1937-1986".
10	2. Flag: add the name "TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION" to the existing flag
11	redesign the feather design.
