

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adopting Seal and Flag for Tohono O'Odham Nation)

RES. NO. 229-86


1 WHEREAS, The qualified voters of the Tohono O'Odham Nation did on January 18,
2 1986, adopt a new Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and
3 WHEREAS, it is necessary for this Council to adopt a seal and flag which will be
4 representative of the Nation under its new Constitution.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that it does hereby adopt the
6 existing seal and flag of the Papago Tribe as the seal and flag of the
7 Tohono O'Odham Nation, subject to the following changes:



- 9 1. Seal: Change the words "GREAT SEAL OF THE PAPAGO TRIBE" to GREAT
10 SEAL OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION;" and the date "1937" to
"1937-1986".
 - 11 2. Flag: add the name "TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION" to the existing flag
12 redesign the feather design.

13 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th
14 day of April, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
15 1269.0 for; 254.0 against; 117.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
16 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (e) of Article VI of the Constitution
17 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
18 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
19 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
20 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
