

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Restructuring and Financing Plan for Legislative
Council, Committees, and Boards)

RES. NO. 232-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did appoint and charge the Ex-
2 ecutive Committee of the Council to develop alternative recommen-
3 dations and plans to implement the mandate of the new Constitution
4 of the Tohono O'odham Nation that the government of the Nation be re-
5 structured and segregated into three independent branches, and specif-
6 ically asked the Committee to review the alternatives and cost effect-
7 iveness of a full time Council; and

9 WHEREAS, The Executive Committee has accordingly recommended that the various
10 existing committees and boards previously established by the Papago
11 Council be restructured into either legislative or executive commi-
12 ttees and Boards; that the legislative committees and boards be fur-
13 ther restructured to generally encompass five to seven members; that,
14 if the Council decides to revise its meeting schedules in order to
15 reduce costs and streamline operations, the membership of these
16 committees and boards be drawn directly from the membership of the
17 Council; that each member of the Council be appointed to a predeter-
18 mined number of the restructured legislative committees or boards
19 charged to advise and inform the Council concerning matters within its
20 jurisdiction and to recommend legislation pertinent thereto; and that,
21 in order for the Council to function effectively as an independent
22 branch of government, the meeting schedules of the Council be revised,
23 effective October 1, 1986, so that the Council will meet either perm-
24 anently or during regular and defined legislative sessions; and

27 WHEREAS, in support of its recommendations, the Executive Committee submitted
28 various alternatives and schedules of estimated costs therefor in a
29 report entitled "Cost Analysis of a Full Time Council," and the
30 Council has determined that the Tohono O'Odham Nation would be best
31 benefitted to adopt a plan which will incorporate the Committee's
32 recommendations and the financing alternative described in Table 2 of



the report entitled "Per Diem for Legislative Days," which will establish regular and defined legislative sessions for the Council which shall not exceed 180 days per year and will compensate Council members (from an initial annual Council budget which shall not exceed \$594,000.00) at a rate of \$150.00 per meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that it does hereby select the foregoing financing alternative, and directs the Executive Committee to develop a plan for the restructuring of the legislative committees and boards and of the Council's meeting schedules which will take effect on October 1, 1986, will incorporate the Committee's recommendations and will call for regular and defined legislative sessions for the Council which shall not exceed 180 days per year and will compensate Council members (from an initial annual Council budget which shall not exceed \$594,000.00) at a rate of \$150.00 per meeting.


The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 8th day of April, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1001.5 for; 638.5 against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) and (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
