

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Support of National Indian Health Board)

RES. NO. 238-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council, formerly the Papago Council, did by  
2 Resolution No. 123-84 create a Community Health Board, and;

3  
4 WHEREAS, The Community Health Board has been established as the policy setting  
5 body for the Tohono O'odham Health Delivery System, and;

6 WHEREAS, A Community Health Board Member, by appointment by the Board, acts as  
7 the official Tucson Area representative to the National Indian Health  
8 Board and as such represents both the Tohono O'odham Nation and the  
9 Pascua Yaqui Tribe, and;

10 WHEREAS, The National Indian Health Board acts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham  
11 Nation and, as stated in the preamble of the Constitution and By-Laws  
12 of the National Indian Health Board, acts on behalf of all Native  
13 American people "as an advocate of self-determination, seeking to  
14 attain ourselves and our posterity the rights and benefits to which  
15 we are entitled to under the laws of United States and our respective  
16 States; and/or treaty rights relating to all aspects of health  
17 services; to enlighten and give the public a better understanding  
18 of matters and problems of health affecting the American Indian and  
19 Alaska Native; to enhance and promote the education and understanding  
20 of members of the above mentioned tribes in matters pertaining to  
21 their health and welfare; to seek and equitable adjustment among  
22 participating tribes and Alaska Natives, of public health services;  
23 and otherwise to promote the common welfare and health, do establish  
24 the organization."

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Council supports the  
28 National Indian Health Board and hereby demonstrates said support  
29 through the designation of an official and empowered representative.

31 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 8th  
32 day of April, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
1277.5 for; 304.0 against; 58.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution

1 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January  
18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
2 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
