

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(All Employees Receive 2 ½ % Cost of Living Increase)


1 WHEREAS; the Budget & Finance Committee of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
2 Council has submitted two alternative proposals which would,
3 effective October 01, 1986, give a 2½% Cost of Living increase to
4 employees, at an estimated annual cost of \$46,890, or (2) only
5 to employees who earn less than the average wage of \$12,483, at
6 an estimated annual cost of \$28,400; and

7 WHEREAS: the Council believes that all employees should receive a Cost of
8 Living increase.


9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that all employees of the
10 Tohono O'Odham Nation should receive a 2½% Cost of Living
11 increase, at an estimated annual cost of \$46,890, effective
12 October 01, 1986.

13 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 11th
14 day of April, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
1254.5 for; 268.5 against; 117.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
15 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the
16 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
17 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 06, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (34 Stat. 984).
