(Approving Salary Schedule for Judges)

1 WHEREAS, The Law & Order Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
2 has proposed a Job Description of the appointment of the Judges of
3 the Tohono O'odham Courts and a schedule of compensation for the
4 Judges; and

6 WHEREAS, The Council concurs with the Law & Order Committee's recommendation
7 concerning the proposed compensation for the Judges based upon
8 training and experience.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that it does hereby approve and
10 adopt the attached schedule of compensation proposed by the Law &
11 Order Committee for the Judges of the Tohono O'odham Courts.

13 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 11th
14 day of April, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
15 1391.5 for; 169.5 against; 79.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
16 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution
17 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
18 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
19 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
20 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
