

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Rescinding Resolution No. 228-86)


1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did by Resolution No. 228-86
2 direct that all primary representatives and their alternates on this
3 Council who also hold office of representatives or alternates on a
4 District Council shall submit their resignation from one of these
5 Councils by May 7, 1986, in conformity with the mandate of Article X,
6 Section 3 of the Constitution; and

7 WHEREAS, The Council has received evidence of resignations by most, but not
8 all, of the representatives and alternates who hold elective public
9 office on both Councils and the Council believes that the matter
10 should be submitted to the Districts for further direction. To give
11 the districts an opportunity to decide whether the representatives
12 should abide by Article 10 Section 3 which states "No person holding
13 an elective public office of the Tohono O'odham Nation shall hold any
14 other elective office of the Tohono O'odham Nation" or Article 11
15 Section 3 which states "Upon adoption of this constitution, the
16 Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Papago Council shall assume the
17 offices of Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation,
18 and all other elected public officers of the Tohono O'odham Nation
19 shall continue in office for the remainder of their respective terms".

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that it does hereby rescind
23 Resolution No. 228-86 and directs that the matter be submitted to the
24 Districts for a period of thirty days for further direction.

25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 7th
26 day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
27 832.5 for; 738.5 against; 69.0 not voting and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers
28 vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) and (1) of Article VI of the Consti-
29 tution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on
30 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian
31 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
32 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
