(Adoption into the Tohono O'odham Nation)

1 WHEREAS, MURRIETTA, Mary F.; has made application for adoption in the Tohono
2 O'odham Nation pursuant to Section 2 of Article II of the Constitution
3 of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

5 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has reviewed the respective application, had
6 made a final determination that she is 1/2 degree or more of Papago-
7 Tohono O'odham Indian blood, and have made a recommendation to the
8 Tohono O'odham Council that the application be approved, all in ac-
9 cordance with the provisions of the Enrollment Ordinance; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Council has reviewed the recommendation of the En-
11 rollment Committee and the evidence submitted in support of the
12 individual application.

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14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that the appli-
15 cation for adoption filed by:

17 is hereby approved and is hereby adopted into membership of the Tohono
18 O'odham Nation.

19 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 8th
20 day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1397.0 for; -0- against; 243.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
22 powers vested in the Council by Section 2 of Article II and Article VI Section
23 1(h) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
24 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

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


