

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Amending BIA/Tribal Budget Priorities FY-1988)

RES. NO. 265-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs has submitted to
2 the Tohono O'odham Council the projected funding amounts for FY-1988;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council is required to establish Agency program
5 priorities and set program funding and staffing levels by using the
6 Decision Ranking Chart; and


7 WHEREAS, The Decision Ranking Chart allows the Tohono O'odham Nation to par-
8 ticipate in the Federal Budget process and to allocate resources in
9 the most cost efficient manner which will provide maximum services
10 and benefits for its members; and

11 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council has reviewed the decision units and has
12 determined that it is in the best interest of the Nation that the
13 line item number eight (8) entitled Self Determination Grant Services
14 be substituted by a new line item number eight (8) entitled Credit
15 and Finance, to be funded in part by funds previously allocated to
16 Self Determination Grant Services and in part by funds previously
17 allocated to line item number nine (9) entitled Aid to Tribal Govern-
18 ment.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it does
22 hereby amend the Decision Ranking Chart as specified above and that
23 the Tohono O'odham Nation contract the program funded by line item
24 number eight (8) Credit and Finance.

26 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9th
27 day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
28 1024.0 for; 478.0 against; -0- not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the
29 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution
30 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
31 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
32 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
