

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance)

RES. NO. 268-86

1 WHEREAS, 1) The TERO Commission while maximizing TERO ordinance employment on
2 existing projects, has recognized the critical need for new em-
3 ployment opportunities to be created through tribal and district
4 economic initiative, and

5
6 WHEREAS, 2) In the process of enforcing the TERO Ordinance, the Commissioners
7 have recognized the need for a comprehensive approach to economic
8 development that includes:

- 9 a. enforcement of the Nation's preference law;
10 b. new industry on the reservation owned by the Nation, the
11 districts and tribal members;
12 c. new business codes and ordinances to promote the legal climate
13 for economic activity; and

14 WHEREAS, 3) There is a limited window of opportunity for the Nation and/or its
15 districts to acquire the ownership of mature and profitable companies
16 and relocate them to the reservation. To benefit from this window
17 requires expedited action by the Nation.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the TERO Ordinance No. 01-85 is hereby
19 amended by adding a new section, "Section 18 - Economic Development",
20 which shall read as follows:

21 Section 18 - Economic Development

- 22 A. The TERO Commission no later than September 30, 1986, shall submit
23 to the Council the following:
24
25 1. A list, along with supporting material of proposed acqui-
26 sitions of existing companies that the Nation and/or districts
27 could purchase and relocate to the Reservation.
28 2. Proposed business codes to promote a positive legal business
29 climate in the Nation and to enable the Nation, the districts
30 and members to obtain maximum benefit from the rights and
31 opportunities available to them through the Nation's inherent
32 sovereign powers in the area of business and commerce.
3. A proposed plan for a comprehensive and integrated tribal
office that would:
a. identify and develop economic opportunities in the
Nation,

- b. oversee and monitor all economic enterprises owned by the Nation,
- c. enforce all business and commerce codes enacted by the Nation,
- d. perform such other functions as are necessary to produce economic growth within the Nation.

B. In performing the tasks specified above the Commission is hereby authorized and empowered to:


- 1. Use such existing staff of the Commission to perform these tasks;
- 2. With such funds as may be authorized and appropriated by the Council, to employ financial experts and other consultants to assist the Commission to perform these tasks;
- 3. To pay travel expenses and other necessary costs that are incurred in the performance of these tasks.

C. That it does hereby authorize and appropriate to the Commission the sum of \$35,000 derived from employment rights fee, pursuant to Section 11 of the ordinance; to perform the tasks set out above.

D. That all agencies and divisions of the Nations, and all entities representing or assisting the Nation, districts and members in the area of economic development, shall provide information and materials on present and future activities and shall otherwise cooperate with the Commission in implementation of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9th day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 888.5 for; 613.5 against; -0- not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c) and (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
