

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Food Distribution & Family Nutrition Services)

RES. NO. 272-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated successfully a program whereby
2 the diet and nutritional needs of eligible Tohono O'Odham people have
3 been served by supplementing other federal social service programs;
4 and
5

6 WHEREAS, The funding for the Tohono O'Odham Food Distribution/Family Nutrition
7 Services has been provided through the United States Department of
8 Agriculture; and

9 WHEREAS, The continued operation of the Food Distribution Program is essential
10 to provide basic diet and nutrition for eligible clients; and

11 WHEREAS, A proposal for continued funding of the Food Distribution Program has
12 been prepared by the Food Distribution program and is in accordance
13 with funding guidelines of USDA;

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant will be from October 1,
16 1986 through September 30, 1987 unless extended by mutual agreement of
17 both contracting parties;

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that the Tohono O'Odham
19 Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while nego-
20 tiations are still being conducted and no executed Grant has been
21 awarded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture:

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it hereby
24 approves the application for continued funding of the Tohono O'Odham
25 Food Distribution/Family Nutrition Services from the U.S. Department
26 of Agriculture; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-
28 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, are hereby authorized to apply
29 for, and negotiate and execute any and all grants, amendments and
30 other documents necessary to secure funding for the continued operation
31 of the Tohono O'Odham Food Distribution Program, provided however that
32

1 any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant
2 shall be submitted for further prior approval by this council.

3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 19th
4 day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
5 1502.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the
6 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
7 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January
8 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
9 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
10 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
