

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Law Enforcement)

RES. NO. 273-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Law Enforcement
2 under FY 1986 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs;
3 and
4
5 WHEREAS, Such Tribal operation have been successful and beneficial to the
6 Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and
7
8 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all
9 proposals to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono
10 O'Odham Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract
11 termination; and
12
13 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Council does desire to recontract for provisions of
14 these services during FY 1987; and
15
16 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the Law Enforce-
17 ment contract.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it does
20 authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with
21 the Tohono O'Odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 regulations and procedures
22 for the provisions of services titled Law Enforcement.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will be from October
25 1, 1986 and end on September 30, 1987 unless extended by mutual agree-
26 ment of both contracting parties;

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
29 programs from which contracts are requested herewith which have not
30 been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to
31 the start of the funding year.

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-
34 Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation is
35 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any
36 amendment thereto for the duration of the contracts, provided however,
37 that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the

contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 19th day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1502.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
