

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Human Services Program)

RES. NO. 274-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Human Services
2 Program under FY 1986 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian
3 Affairs; and

4 WHEREAS, Such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the
5 Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and

6 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all
7 proposals to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono
8 O'Odham Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract
9 termination; and

10 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Council does desire to recontract for provisions of
11 these services during FY 1987; and

12 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the Human
13 Services Program contract.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it does auth-
15 orize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the
16 Tohono O'Odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for
17 the provisions of services titled: Human Services Program.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall commence on October
19 1, 1986 and end on September 30, 1987.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
21 programs from which contracts are requested herewith which have not
22 been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to
23 the start of the funding year.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr.,
25 Vice-Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham
26 Nation is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts
27 and any amendment thereto for the duration of the contracts, provided,
28 however that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of

1 the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
2 council.

4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 19th
5 day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
6 1261.0 for; 291.0 against; -0- not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the
7 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of
8 the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
9 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secre-
10 tary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
11 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
