

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Children's Home Program)

RES. NO. 275-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Tohono O'Odham
2 Children's Home Program under FY 1986 P.L. 93-638 contract with the
3 Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
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5 WHEREAS, Such Tribal operation have been successful and beneficial to the
6 Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and

7 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all
8 proposals to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono
9 O'Odham Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract
10 termination; and

11 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Council does desire to recontract for provisions of
12 these services during FY 1987; and
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14 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the Tohono
15 O'Odham Children's Home Program Contract.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it does auth-
17 orize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the
18 Tohono O'Odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for
19 the provisions of services titled: Tohono O'Odham Children's Home
20 Program.
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22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall commence on October
23 1, 1986 and end on September 30, 1987.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
25 programs from which contracts are requested herewith which have not
26 been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to
27 the start of the funding year.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr. Vice-
29 Chairman; or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation is
30 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any
31 amendment thereto for the duration of the contracts, provided however
32 that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the

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contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 19th day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1502.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
