

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Adult Care Group Home)

RES. NO. 276-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently subcontracting for non-medical
2 adult custodial care with off reservation providers under the P.L.
3 93-638 Social Service Contract; and
4

5 WHEREAS, Such off reservation placements are detrimental to the well being of
6 the people; and

7 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to contract for the establish-
8 ment and operation of an on reservation Adult Care Group Home; and

9 WHEREAS, Such a community based program will be beneficial to the people; and

10 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Nation has successfully operated other group care
11 facilities; and

12 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all
13 contract proposals be submitted to the Tohono O'Odham Council for
14 approval at least 120 days prior; and
15

16 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Council does desire to contract for provisions of
17 Adult Custodial Care through a tribal group home; and

18 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the Adult Cus-
19 todial Care Group Home contract.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it
21 does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract
22 with the Tohono O'odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 regulations and
23 procedures for the provisions of services titles: Adult Care Group
24 Home.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall commence on October
27 01, 1986 and end on September 30, 1987.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate
29 programs from which contracts are requested herewith which have not
30 been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior
31 to the start of the funding year.


1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-
2 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Tohono O'odham Nation
3 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and
4 any amendment thereto for the duration of the contracts, provided how-
5 ever that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of
6 the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
7 Council.

9 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th
10 day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
11 1502.0 for; -0- against; 138.0 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the
12 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
13 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
14 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
15 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
16 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
