

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'odham Alcoholism & Substance Abuse Prevention and  
Rehabilitation Program)

RES. NO. 279-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated an Alcoholism  
2 Program for its people; and

3  
4 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council recognizes that Alcoholism is one of the  
5 most pressing and chronic health problems confronting the Tohono  
6 O'odham people; and

7 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Alcoholism Program intends to continue providing  
8 services to eligible clients by structuring its program into three  
9 areas: youth services, adult services, and operation of a Rehabili-  
10 tation Center; and

11 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 require that all proposals to recontract under  
12 P.L. 93-638 regulations be submitted for approval to the Tohono  
13 O'odham Council at least 120 days prior to the contract termination;  
14 and

15  
16 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council purposes to continue the Tohono O'odham  
17 Alcoholism program during FY 87 by contracting P.L. 93-638 funds;  
18 and

19 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council has reviewed and approved the Alcoholism  
20 program contract.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it does  
23 authorize and request the Public Health, Indian Health Service to  
24 contract with the Tohono O'odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 regulations  
25 and procedures for the provision of services titled: Alcoholism &  
26 Substance Abuse and Rehabilitation Program; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract will commence on October  
28 01, 1986 through September 30, 1987.


29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate  
30 a program from which contracts are requested herewith which have not  
31 been negotiated and executed by the Indian Health Service prior to  
32

1 the start of the funding year.


2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-  
3 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation  
4 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and  
5 any amendments thereto for the duration of the contracts, provided  
6 however that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels  
7 of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by  
8 this Council.

10 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th  
11 day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
12 1356.0 for; -0- against; 158.0 not voting; and 126.0 absent, pursuant to the  
13 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution  
14 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January  
15 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
16 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
17 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
