

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(The Wise Ones Elderly Program Title VI)

RES. NO. 281-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program of
2 services of the older O'odham members through the office of the Wise
3 Ones Elderly Program; and

5 WHEREAS, Funding for the operation of the Wise Ones Elderly Program has been
6 possible in part by Article VI of the Older American's Act of 1965 as
7 amended; and

8 WHEREAS, The Wise Ones Elderly Program desires to seek continued funding of its
9 program for elderly by submitting a proposal to the Office of Human
10 Development Services, Administration on Aging; and

11 WHEREAS, The Wise Ones Elderly proposal will benefit elder members of the
12 Tohono O'odham Nation by providing for their nutritional and other
13 social and support services; and

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it does
16 hereby approve the proposal to the Office of Human Development for
17 continued funding of the Wise Ones Elderly Program to provide services
18 to qualified residents of the Tohono O'odham Nation.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this grant shall commence on October
20 01, 1986 and end September 30, 1987.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-
23 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation are
24 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these Grants and any a-
25 mendments thereto for the duration of the Grants, provided however that
26 any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the Grant
27 shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

28 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th
29 day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
30 1514.0 for; -0- against; 126.0 not voting; and 05 absent, pursuant to the
31 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
32 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian

1 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
2 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
