

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'odham Early Childhood Program)

RES. NO. 285-86

- 1 WHEREAS, The Early Childhood Education Program of the Tohono O'odham Nation has
2 been and still is an effective and necessary early educational process
3 that is extremely beneficial to the pre-school Tohono O'odham Children;
4 and
5 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Nation has continuously designated that education
6 of its youth is its highest priority; and
7 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs once again has failed to implement the
8 Mandate of P. L. 95-561 - And to secure necessary appropriations to
9 fund the Early Childhood Program; and
10
11 WHEREAS, Congress has directed the Bureau of Indian Affairs to establish a
12 formula for funding for early childhood education programs which
13 funding would continue annually; and
14 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council does desire to recontract for provisions of
15 these services during 1987; and
16 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council has reviewed and approved the Early
17 Childhood contract.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it does
20 authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with
21 the Tohono O'odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures
22 for the provisions of services titled: Early Childhood Program; and
23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract will commence on October
24 01, 1986 through September 30, 1987.
25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate
26 a program from which contracts are requested herewith which have not
27 been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior
28 to the start of the funding year.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-
31 Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Tohono O'odham Council is
32 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any

amendments thereto for the duration of the contracts, provided however that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
