

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'odham Skill Center)

RES. NO. 290-86

1 WHEREAS, Congress has appropriated \$143,000.00 in 1985 for the training of
2 Tohono O'odham people in construction trades at the Tohono O'odham
3 Skill Center; and

4 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Part 271 provides the Tohono O'odham Nation with the mechanism
5 to contract for Bureau programs; and

6 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council does desire to contract for provisions of
7 these services during FY 1987; and

8
9 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council has reviewed and approved the Tohono
10 O'odham Skill Center Program contract.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it does
12 authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with
13 the Tohono O'odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 regulations and procedures
14 for the provisions of services titles: Tohono O'odham Skill Center.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall commence on August
16 01, 1986 and end July 1987.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate
19 a program from which contracts are requested herewith which have not
20 been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to
21 the award.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr. Vice-
23 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation
24 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and
25 any amendments thereto for the duration of the contracts, provided
26 however that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels
27 of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
28 Council.

30 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th
31 day of May, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
32 1471.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 169.0 absent, pursuant to the
powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian

1 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
2 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
