

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Advertising positions of Judges of Tohono O'odham Courts)

RES. NO. 298-86


1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is charged by Article VIII of
2 the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation to appoint six judges of
3 the Tohono O'odham Courts; and

4 WHEREAS, The Council has not received sufficient qualified applications to fill
5 the positions as previously advertised.


6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Law and Order Committee readvertise the
7 positions pursuant to a job description which does not make the fluent
8 use of the Tohono O'odham language a mandatory condition for the po-
9 sition, but rather a preferred condition, and that the committee bring
10 its recommendations to this Council within sixty days.

11 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th
12 day of June, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
13 1254.5 for; 269.0 against; 116.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
14 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI and Section 3 and
15 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
16 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
17 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
