

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(To override veto of Resolution No. 268-86)

RES. NO. 300-86

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did by Resolution No. 268-86
2 amend the Employment Rights Ordinance, Ordinance No. 01-85, by adding
3 a new Section 18, entitled "Economic Development;" and



5 WHEREAS, Upon presentation of the Resolution to the Chairman of the Tohono
6 O'odham Nation he did disapprove thereof and returned it to the
7 Council with his objections in accordance with the provisions of Arti-
8 cle VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of the Nation; and

9 WHEREAS, The Council has reviewed the Chairman's objections and after consider-
10 ation again voted to pass Resolution No. 268-86.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council does hereby override the
12 Chairman's veto of Resolution No. 268-86.

14 The foregoing resolution was presented to the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th
15 day of June, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present and, by a vote of
16 825.0 for; 815.0 against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, failed to override
17 the Chairman's veto of Resolution No. 268-86 pursuant to the powers vested in
18 the Council by Section 5 of Article VII of the Constitution of the Tohono
19 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and
20 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)
21 on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
22 984).
