
1 WHEREAS, The Executive Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has
2 presented to the Council a report, entitled Legislative Calendar
3 Options, suggesting three separate options for Council meetings or
4 sessions, starting October 1, 1986; and

6 WHEREAS, The Council must decide which option, if any, the Council should adopt
7 in order to permit development of a budget recommendations for FY 1987.


8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the three options recommended by the Ex-
9 ecutive Committee be placed on the Council's action agenda.

10 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th
11 day of June, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
12 1037.0 for; 603.0 against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
13 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution
14 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
15 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
16 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
17 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
