

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Juvenile Diversion Program)

RES. NO. 311-86

1 WHEREAS, The Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974 mandates
2 to States the development of a flexible network of service and
3 placement options for alleged Juvenile offenders, and (2) maintenance
4 of a Juvenile's family and Community ties; and

5
6 WHEREAS, The Act mandates to States planning and implementation process for
7 which; (1) is based upon a recognition of youth rights and due process
8 and which promotes the advocacy of such, and (2) uses active citizen
9 participation and youth involvement; and

10 WHEREAS, The Act mandates to States enhanced capacity for parents, schools and
11 police to resolve problems of youth in a non-judicial manner and thus
12 alleviate the use of jails and lock-ups. This includes, where ap-
13 propriate, the coordination and integration of public and private
14 child welfare services; and

16 WHEREAS, The Act mandates to States identification and description of viable
17 alternatives to the use of jails and lock-ups; and

18 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Nation of Arizona has expressed a willingness to
19 participate in the provisions of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency
20 Prevention Act of 1974 where applicable as stated in Resolution Number
21 24-81; and

23 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Children's Court has submitted a proposal for
24 "Reverted/Unused Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act funds
25 entitled The Tohono O'odham Juvenile Diversion Program which addresses
26 systems development and reduction of youth alcohol and substance abuse.

27 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th
28 day of June, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
29 1343.0 for; 101.0 against; 58.0 not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the
30 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
31 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
32 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
