

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Acceptance of Title II Grant)



1 WHEREAS, The Papago Human Services department has the primary
2 responsibility to provide for the care, treatment and
3 welfare of children found to be in need of such care; and
4 and
5 WHEREAS, Title II of the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978 provides
6 funds for development of child welfare programs under
7 specified terms and conditions; and
8 WHEREAS, The incidence of teenage parents on the Papago
9 Reservation is high and school based day care and after
10 school care is not available to this group; and
11 WHEREAS, The Papago Human Service department is capable of
12 developing and administering day care program that will
13 focus on keeping teenage parents in school and provide
14 educational component to increase parent skills; and
15 WHEREAS, The need for such a program is well documented and
16 Papago Human Services is capable of implementing the
17 programs.
18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does
19 hereby approve the application of the Papago Human
20 Services a three year Title II grant to develop and
21 implement a Teen Parent school based Day Care and
22 decrease the incidents of child abuse and neglect and
23 decrease school drop-outs of teen parents through a
24 school based day care program with educational and
25 social service component.
26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco
27 Jose, Jr., Vice Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, of
28 the Papago Council is hereby authorized to negotiate
29 and execute this Grant and any amendments thereto for
30 the duration of the Grant
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The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 06th day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,369.0 for; -0- against; 271.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
