1 WHEREAS, This day's agenda reflects review of a Justice Program Grant; and
2 WHEREAS, The Grant has previously been referred by this Council to the Law
3 and Order Committee to eliminate the Prosecuting Attorney position and
4 rebudget \$42,391.00 and return the budget to Council

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Justice Program Grant is again referred
7 to the Law and Order Committee for review and comment before it is
8 brought to this Council for action.

9 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9th
10 day of July, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
11 1145.0 for; 297.5 against; 197.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
12 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution
13 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
14 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
15 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
16 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




