in Pisinemo and San Xavier)

1 WHEREAS, the Education Department has provided reading and library services to
2 interested persons, particularly to school aged children through its
3 library department, the Venito Garcia Library and extension libraries
4 in Pisinemo and San Xavier; and

6 WHEREAS, the Venito Garcia Library and the Pisinemo and San Xavier extension
7 libraries, provides services in oral story-telling, recreational
8 reading, cultural resources and audio visual materials; and

9 WHEREAS, the funds appropriated for the expenses of the library are provided
10 through the Education Department's annual budget; and


11 WHEREAS, receipt of any funds will enable the Venito Garcia Library and the ex-
12 tension libraries in Pisinemo and San Xavier to provide additional
13 library services

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it does
16 hereby approve the proposal submitted to the U.S. Department of Educ-
17 ation, Office of Research and Improvement, Library Programs for
18 funding of the Venito Garcia Library and the extension libraries in
19 Pisinemo and San Xavier.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that Josiah Moore, Chair-
21 man; Francisco Jose, Vice-Chairman; or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of
22 the Tohono O'Odham Nation are authorized to execute any and all
23 documents required for receipt of the funds from the U.S. Department
24 of Education, Office of Research and Improvement, Library programs.

26 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 10th
27 day of July, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
28 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers
29 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
30 Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
