

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY-87 Head Start
Handicapped Services)

RES. NO. 363-86

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham nation has consistently supported the nurturment of
2 its young members by providing for their welfare through various pro-
3 grams and services designed to meet their special needs; and

5 WHEREAS, the Head Start program has been successfully operated through the
6 Early Childhood department and has served many young Tohono O'Odham
7 children; and

8 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for
9 Children, Youth and Families, has requested a separate proposal for
10 Handicapped Services funding; and

11 WHEREAS, the Head Start program has applied for funding to provide Handicapped
12 Services to diagnosed special needs children including individualized
13 education plans in accordance with PL-94-142; and

15 WHEREAS, the Grants & Contracts office has reviewed the proposed grant and
16 finds the same to be of benefit to the Head Start program

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that it does
18 hereby approve the proposed grant for Handicapped Services.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that Josiah Moore, Chair-
20 man; Francisco Jose, Vice-Chairman; or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of
21 the Tohono O'Odham Nation are authorized to negotiate and execute any
22 and all grants, amendments and documents necessary to secure funding
23 for the continued operation of the Head Start program.

25 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 10th
26 day of July, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
27 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers
28 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
29 Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
