3 Cruz Development within the San Xavier District; and


4 WHEREAS, An agenda with ground rules has been proposed for today's meeting of

9 and, for this meeting to be in Open Session.


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it does hereby

19 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
20 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
21 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
22 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
