

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Modifying Council Agenda with changes)

RES. NO. 376-86

1 WHEREAS, The Legislative Council did set today's meeting to hear a preliminary
2 report from the Standing Committee regarding Santa Cruz Properties,
3 Inc.; and

4 WHEREAS, The Council did act to amend the agenda; and

5 WHEREAS, The Standing Committee is concerned about the reception of the persons
6 invited to speak before the Legislative Council; and

7 WHEREAS, The Standing Committee does not want to proceed unless the meeting is
8 conducted in a manner whereby the presentators are not harassed or
9 intimidated in any manner.

10 WHEREAS, The Committee is willing to proceed with the original agenda as long
11 as the presentators as listed on the agenda are treated as guests and
12 are allowed to complete their presentations; and

13 WHEREAS, The following recommendations were made:

- 15 1. To go with the original agenda presented but to change the session
16 from a Closed to an Open Meeting.
 - 17 2. To disregard the groundrules and for members of the Legislature
18 to conduct themselves in a professional and courteous manner by
19 not harassing the presentators in any manner.
 - 20 3. To hear the archaeological report in a Closed Session.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby adopts the
22 the original agenda for today and to open the meeting to the public;
23 and deletes the groundrules proposed and to further order to conduct
24 the meeting in a manner benefitting a Legislative Council by allowing
25 the invited speakers to make their presentations without any harassment
26 or intimidation at anytime and in any form and that time be allowed for
27 questions and answers.

29 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th
30 day of August, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
31 1318.0 for; 322.0 against; -0- not voting; and -01- absent, pursuant to the
32 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution
of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
