
RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL


1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council did set aside August 5th, 1986 to hear the  
2 Preliminary Report from the Standing Committee; and  
3 WHEREAS, The Committee has recommended that the Archaeological portion of the  
4 report be in Closed Session due to the critical aspects of this issue;

7 WHEREAS, The Legislative Council does hereby go along with the recommendation  
8 of the Committee but to open it to all Tribal members.  
9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the Archaeologi-  
10 cal Report be in Closed Session but open to all Tribal members and  
11 closed to non-members of this Nation.

13 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th  
14 day of August, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
15 819.5 for; 820.5 against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers  
16 vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) and (c), (2), (7) and (8) of Article VI  
17 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham  
18 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
19 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
20 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
