WHEREAS, the San Lucy District is in the process of studying Federal lands within the State of Arizona for the purpose of finding suitable Federal land for exchange of tribal lands within the Gila Bend Reservation that were rendered unsuitable by reason of the Operation of Painted Rock Dam; and

WHEREAS, It is the desire of the San Lucy District that a study be done on privately held land in the State of Arizona that might be suitable for such exchange and the results of said study to be used in the hearings and negotiations that will take place this year in the processing of the Gila Bend Settlement bill through Congress; and

WHEREAS, Section 308(h) of P.L. 97-293 only authorizes the study of Federal lands for purpose of exchange and it will be necessary to authorize sufficient funding to study privately held lands; and

WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe and the San Lucy District if \$35,000.00 is authorized for said study and these funds be taken from the income that has been accumulated to the principle of the Trust fund that was established under Section 309 of P.L. 97-293.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does hereby authorize the expenditure of funds, not to exceed \$35,000.00, for the study of privately held lands within the State of Arizona that might be suitable for the exchange of Tribal lands within the Gila Bend Reservation that were rendered unsuitable by reason of the Operation of Painted Rock Dam.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these funds shall be taken from the income that has accrued to the principle of the Trust funds that was established under section 309 of P.L. 97-293.

RES. NO. 37-86 (Study of Private lands for Gila Bend Land exchange)

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day of February, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1456.5 for; 63.0 against; 120.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) and Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
