

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'odham Justice Program)

RES. NO. 380-86

1 WHEREAS, Section 104(a) of P. L. 93-638 does authorize the granting of funds for
2 the purpose of "strengthening and improving the tribal government"; and

3 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$213,900.00 of FY 1987 funds
4 for such grant purposes to the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

5 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Nation does have need to strengthen and develop its
6 Tribal government and management, by operating a Justice Program in the
7 amount of \$180,214.00; and

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Council does request the
10 amount of at least \$213,900.00 for FY 1987 to be budgeted as reviewed
11 and approved by the Tohono O'odham Council. Any remaining balance of
12 grant funds will be budgeted for indirect costs.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby approves the
14 Administrative Assistant I position as a new position with a revised
15 position description.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this grant shall commence on October 01,
18 1986 and end September 30, 1987.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francosco Jose, Jr., Vice-
20 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation are
21 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these grants and any a-
22 mendments thereto for the duration of the grants, provided however that
23 any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant
24 shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

26 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th
27 day of August, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
28 1399.0 for; 241.0 against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers
29 vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
30 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Oper-
ations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
Stat. 984).
