WHEREAS, On the 21st day of August, 1985, the San Lucy District Council duly
enacted Resolution No. 36-85 wherein it approved a Legislative Bill
regarding the Gila Bend Reservation substantially in conformity with
the terms and conditions of the proposed Congressional Bill attached
hereto and made a part hereof; and
WHEREAS, On the 4th day of April, 1985, the Tohono O'odham Council duly enacted
Resolution No. 43-84 wherein it approved the terms and conditions of

Resolution No. 43-84 wherein it approved the terms and conditions of the proposed Legislation attached hereto, with the condition that any material modifications, alterations, changes or additions to the Legislation that would affect the benefits to be received by the District and the Nation must first be subject to approval of the District and the Nation; and

whereas, It has been proposed by Congressional staff that in order to meet some of the objections of the Administration and improve the prospects for the enactment of beneficial Legislation, Section 4(a) should be modified substantially as follows:

- 1. The \$30,000,000 to be paid to the Nation for the assignment of 9,880 acres of land within the Gila Bend Reservation would be modified so that the Nation would receive \$15,000,000 in cash with interest from the date of enactment and the right to acquire available BLM land in the State of Arizona under the control of the Secretary of the Interior having a value of \$15,000,000 at date of the enactment.
- 2. The Nation would have the right to sell or exchange this BLM land for the State or private lands within the State of Arizona.
- 3. Proceeds of any sale of BLM lands and the \$15,000,000 received by the Nation for assigning 9,880 acres of land within the Gila Bend Reservation shall be held and used in accordance with the provisions of Section 5(a) of the Congressional Bill attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, The other provisions of the proposed Legislation shall remain basically intact; and

WHEREAS, The San Lucy District Council has enacted a resolution approving the above modification to the proposed Legislation if the Congressional
