

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Study of Private lands for Gila Bend land exchange)

RES. NO. 38-86


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has authorized by Resolution
2 No. 37-86 the expenditure of funds, not to exceed
3 \$35,000.00, for the study of privately held lands in the
4 State of Arizona that might be suitable for the exchange
5 of Tribal lands within the Gila Bend Reservation that
6 were rendered unsuitable by reason of the Operation of
7 Painted Rock Dam. Said funds to be taken from the income
8 that has accrued to the Trust funds that was established
9 under Section 309 of P.L. 97-293; and

10 WHEREAS, the Council believes that it would be in the best inter-
11 est of the Tribe if the Papago Tribe solicited proposal
12 from available concerns qualified to make such a study.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does
14 hereby direct that letters together with a description of
15 the requirement of the study be sent to available con-
16 cerns qualified to make such a study with a request for
17 a proposal to be considered by the tribe prior to contact
18 negotiations.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
20 the 7TH day of FEBRUARY, 1986, at a meeting at which a
21 quorum was present with a vote of 776.0 for; 475.0 against;
22 389.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the author-
23 ity vested in the Council by Section 2(a) and (h) of Article V
24 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended,
25 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved
26 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
27 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Res-
28 olution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior
29 and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
30 Council.
