

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Revocation of Membership in Tohono O'Odham Nation)

RES. NO. 400-86

1 WHEREAS, Article II, Sec. 3 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation
2 provides that membership in the Nation, and all rights deriving there-
3 from, shall be lost or relinquished if a person is or becomes enrolled
4 as a member in another Indian nation, tribe, community or band; and

5 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has determined that the following person(s)
6 who are enrolled as members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are also
7 enrolled as member(s) in another Indian nation, tribe, community or
8 band, namely:

13 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee did serve notice upon the foregoing person(s)
14 that they must either relinquish membership in such other Indian
15 nation, tribe, community or band, or relinquish or lose membership in
16 the Tohono O'Odham Nation in accordance with the provisions of Art. IX
17 Sec. 2 of the Enrollment Ordinance; and

18 WHEREAS, the foregoing person(s) did not relinquish membership in such other
19 Indian nation, tribe, community or band, and the Enrollment Committee
20 has therefore recommended that their membership in this Nation be re-
21 voked by this Council; and

23 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee did serve written notice of its recommend-
24 ation upon the foregoing person(s) or, if a minor or incompetent, upon
25 their parent(s), guardian or other person legally authorized to act on
26 their behalf, as required by Art. IX, Sec. 2 of the Enrollment Ord-
27 inance, and this Council has reviewed the Committee's recommendation
28 and all evidence presented, and from such evidence finds that the
29 foregoing person(s) are enrolled as members of this Nation and are also
30 enrolled as members of another Indian nation, tribe, community or
31 band; that they were given an opportunity to relinquish membership in
32 such other nation, tribe, community or band as required by Art. II,

1 Sec. 3 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation but have
2 failed or refused to do so, and that their membership in the Tohono
3 O'Odham Nation must therefore be revoked.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
5 it does hereby revoke the membership in this Nation of the foregoing
6 persons and that the Enrollment Committee serve notice of this de-
7 termination in accordance with Art. IX, Sec. 2 of the Enrollment
8 Ordinance.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, upon completion of all appeals from this determi-
11 nation or upon expiration of the time allowed for such appeals, as
12 provided in Art. IX, Sec. 2 of the Enrollment Ordinance, the names of
13 the foregoing persons who failed to appeal or to succeed in their
14 appeal shall be removed from the membership roll of the Tohono O'Odham
15 Nation.

17 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 14TH
18 day of August, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
19 vote of 1107.5 for; 320.5 against; 212.0 not voting; and -0- absent,
20 pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (h) of Article VI of
21 the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
22 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secre-
23 tary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
24 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
