5 27, 1986; and


6 WHEREAS, The Legislative Chairperson did recommend to the Council that today's

9 Nation and Nation wide (USA); and


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that Today's meeting

16 day of August, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 917.3 for; 456.0 against; 266.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
18 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution
19 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
20 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
21 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
22 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
