

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Chukut Kuk District Budget FY 87)

RES. NO. 413-86

1 WHEREAS, The Chukut Kuk District Council has considered and reviewed its pro-
2 posed activities for FY 87 and has prepared a budget to cover antici-
3 pated costs and expenses; and

5 WHEREAS, The Chukut Kuk District Council did adopt a proposed budget for FY 87
6 in the amount of \$291,886.00. Said budget to begin on October 1, 1986
7 and end on September 30, 1987; and

8 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Council has reviewed the proposed budget and amends
9 the per diem portion regarding the Council Representatives.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it hereby
11 approves the Chukut Kuk District Council budget in the amount of
12 \$291,886.00 to be expended in accordance with the attached budget.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council's per diem is deleted from
15 the budget.

16 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 10th
17 day of September 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
18 of 1459.5 for; -0- against; 42.5 not voting; and 138.0 absent, pursuant to the
19 powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Consti-
20 tution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


