
1 WHEREAS, The Sells District Council, by Resolution No. 5286, is requesting for

5 the Sells District Council.


6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it does hereby  
7 approve an extension of the Sells District FY 1986 budget to October  
8 31, 1986.

9 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 10th  
10 day of September, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
11 of 506.0 for; 886.5 against; 247.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the  
12 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 d (2) and (3) of Article VI of the  
13 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




