2 for the Tohono O'odham Judiciary; and

3 WHEREAS, The Law & Order Committee did receive additional applicants for these
4 positions; and


5 WHEREAS, The Committee felt it would be in the best interest of the Nation to
6 recommend as many qualified applicants at the next Council session;

8 WHEREAS, The Legislative Council feels that time for readvertising the Judges
9 position is necessary.

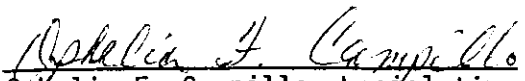
10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED that the opening of the Judges position is extended
11 and that the interviews will take place during the week of October
12 13, 1986.

16 day of September, 1986, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
17 of 1302.0 for; 180.0 against; 158.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
18 powers vested in the Council by Section 3 of Article VIII of the Constitution
19 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
20 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
21 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
22 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
